What is robotic surgery?

Robotic surgery is a minimally invasive procedure that uses computer-assisted technology allowing our surgeons to work with unmatched precision and control. Rather than operating with large incisions, our surgeons use miniature surgical instruments to operate with tiny incisions that reduce scarring, expedite recovery time, and improve overall outcomes.

Phoenixville Hospital is the first in Chester and Montgomery Counties to employ the latest, minimally invasive robotic system. Since 2007, we've performed over 1,200 surgeries using two of these state-of-the-art robots, right in our Robotic Surgery Center. The most common robotic-assisted surgeries we perform include treatments that relate to:

- Gynecologic support
- Hernia repairs
